**LISTING OF POSITION CODES
DETERMINED TO BE CLASSROOM TEACHERS
FOR THE 2015-16 SCHOOL YEAR**

The term classroom teacher is defined in WVC §18A-1-1 as a professional educator who has a direct instructional or counseling relationship with students and who spends the majority of his or her time in this capacity. This has been interpreted by various superintendent interpretations to include the positions listed below.

Consequently, the personnel employed in these positions are entitled to receive the salary enhancements specified by the following Code sections:

- WVC §18A-2-2(g) specifies that classroom teachers who gives written notice to their county boards on or before January 15th of their intention to retire at the conclusion of the school year a \$500 bonus;
- WVC §18A-4-2a specifies that the classroom teachers who have attained the national certificate issued by the National Board of Professional Teaching Standards (NBPTS) are eligible for a \$3,500 bonus; and
- WVC §18A-4-2 specifies that the classroom teachers who have at least 20 or more years of teaching experience are eligible for a \$600 salary supplement.
